I started on atenolol, a heart medication, to prepare me for a surgical procedure which will repair this defect and offer me a long and fulfilling life. Time is of the essence because the longer I go without this vital surgical treatment the more damage my heart will suffer.

I am a happy, sassy pup who loves my family deeply and they love me! I am loving and watchful with Elisha and also have a very special bond with Grace, who has Down's Syndrome. I am her constant companion and when she is outside involved in an activity, I will not leave her side....not even when tempted with a treat. I think my presence acts as therapy. Grace recently underwent a major surgery and it was during this time that we became extra close. I think I was a vital part of her recovery! My puppy love and devotion proved to be just what the doctor ordered! I love my family so much and always want to be their special boy!
